- WHEREAS, the Michigan Karst Conservancy has reviewed the 1989 Statement of Land Trust Standards and Practices developed by the Land Trust Exchange, the national organization of land trusts, and WHEREAS, the Michigan Karst Conservancy agrees that the Standards and Practices described in said Statement are highly desirable for the operation of a sound, effective and sustainable land conservation program; and WHEREAS, the Michigan Karst Conservancy wishes to bring its practices into compliance with these Standards and Practices
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Trustees of the Michigan Karst Conservancy, having reviewed its operating practices and found them in substantial compliance with relevant content of the 1989 Statement of Land Trust Standards and Practices as issued by the Land Trust Exchange, hereby adopts the Statement as henceforth guiding the practices of the organization.
