

## **600 PROJECTS**

- 600-7 Field Trips 4-13-85  
The MKC shall conduct spring and fall field trips.
- 600-10 Option to Buy Bolton Sink 4-13-85  
The Executive Board is authorized to purchase an option on the ten acre Kline parcel containing the Bolton Sink not to exceed a price of \$5,500., contingent upon an agreement for purchase or donation of, or acquisition of a conservation easement on that portion of the adjacent Losinski property that includes the sinkhole and an appropriate buffer.
- 600-17 Authorization to Purchase Kline Property 4-12-86  
The Executive Board is authorized to purchase the ten acre Kline parcel containing the Bolton Sink for a total price not to exceed \$5,000., without contingent requirements on the donation, purchase, or acquisition of adjacent property or easements.
- 600-21 Twin Sinks 8-9-86  
The Executive Board is authorized to approve, and the President to sign, a sales agreement with the owner(s) of Twin Sinks, for the SE 19.5 acres, more or less, of NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 8, T.32N.-R.6E.
- 600-23 Twin Sinks Lease 11-8-86  
The Executive Board is authorized to approve, and the President to sign, a lease for the Twin Sinks in Alpena County, MI.
- 600-80 Twin Sinks 11-4-89  
The MKC Executive Board is authorized to continue negotiation with the Alpena Karst Preservation Committee leading to purchase of 30 acres more or less containing Twin Sinks.
- 600-91 Approval to Purchase Twin Sinks 11-17-90  
The Board of Trustees of the Michigan Karst Conservancy approves the purchase of the "Twin Sinks" property in Alpena Co., consisting of 27.5 acres-plus, along Leer Road in Sec.8, Long Rapids Township, for a price not to exceed \$600/acre, plus necessary closing costs, and providing that clear title to the land is conveyed to Michigan Karst Conservancy.

- 600-92 Approval to Close on Purchase of Twin Sinks 11-17-90  
The Board of Trustees of the Michigan Karst Conservancy authorizes the President to proceed with all necessary actions for Closing and financing, including execution of a Sales Agreement, Recording of Deed, agreement of financing terms, etc. In case of the unavailability of the President, he may appoint another officer with power of attorney to execute the purchase documents.
- 600-93 Acknowledgment of Stevens Gift to Purchase Twin Sinks 11-17-90  
On behalf of the Michigan Karst Conservancy, the Alpena Community, and the present and future generation who will benefit from the preservation of the unique natural karst features of Alpena County, the Board of Trustees accepts with thanks the generous gift of \$10,000 from William C. Stevens and Archibald H. Stevens, to be used for the purchase of the Twin Sinks property, Alpena County, Michigan.
- 600-121 Karst Survey of Hiawatha National Forest 9-18  
The Board authorizes the President to discuss with Hiawatha National Forest (HNF) the establishment of a Memorandum of Understanding concerning a Karst Survey of HNF and other related issues.
- 600-134 Michigan Basin Geology Society Field Trip 11-19-94  
The MKC agrees to co-sponsor the Michigan Basin Geology Society Field Trip with the Michigan Basin Geology Society and the American Institute of Professional Geologists, on April 21-22, 1995, in Alpena, MI, and appoints Tom Rea as liaison representing the MKC.
- 600-155 Project 319 7-25-98  
It is the intent of the MKC to proceed with the protection treatment of the Stevens Twin Sinks Preserve in cooperation with the NE Michigan Karst Aquifer Protection 319 Project subject to discovery of funding source.
