

601 PROJECTS - FIBORN KARST PRESERVE

- 601-28 Naming of the Fiborn Karst Property 3-28-87
The Name of the Fiborn Karst property, following Closing, shall be "The Fiborn Karst Preserve."
- 601-30 Use Policies for The Fiborn Karst Preserve 3-28-87
1. The following are not permitted in The Fiborn Karst Preserve:
 - a. Fires.
 - b. Camping.
 - c. Littering or dumping.
 - d. Alteration of any natural feature.
 - e. Collecting of firewood.
 - f. Vehicle use off-roads.
 - g. Firearm use, except during firearm hunting season.
 - h. Trapping.
 - i. Pollution of soil or streams.
 2. Permission from the Preserve Committee is required for:
 - a. Climbing or caving.
 - b. Scientific collecting of minerals, flora or fauna.
 - c. Excavation or movement of soil or rocks.
 - d. Installation of instrumentation.
 3. Climbing and caving in the Preserve is permitted in accord with the following:
 - a. An experienced climber or caver must accompany each group.
 - b. A liability release and an acknowledgement of use policies for the Preserve must be signed by every visitor.

- 601-58 Fiborn Karst Preserve Release (revised) 8-6-88

- 601-33 Member Reservations to Visit Fiborn Karst Preserve Caves and Climbs 7-11-87
Members must make reservations through the Preserve Committee for all visits to Fiborn Karst Preserve caves or climbs. A single Fiborn Karst Preserve Release signed by a member will apply to all subsequent visits of that member to a Preserve cave or climb, while the member remains in good standing. This privilege terminates upon interruption of membership or when cancelled by action of the Board of Trustees.

- 601-48 Fiborn Karst Preserve Interim Management Plan 3-12-88
The Board of Trustees approves the edited interim management plan for publication with additions as accepted by the Preserve Committee. (See Appendix E.)
- 601-38 Reid Property Lease 11-7-87
The Board of Trustees approves the lease of the Dean and Debra Reid Property as executed on 25 July 1987. Dean and Debra Reid shall be named as Additional Insureds in our Insurance coverage for the Reid Lease. The Reid property shall be managed by the Fiborn Karst Preserve Committee in accord with the terms of the lease. The Reid property is not open to the public except by express permission of the Preserve Committee.
- 601-44 Fiborn Karst Preserve, Project No 1 Description. 11-7-87
The MKC adopts the Fiborn Karst Preserve, Project No 1 description. (See Appendix D.)
- 601-54 Special Use Permit for State Land 8-6-88
The MKC accepts the terms and conditions for a Special Use Permit for State land, N 1/2, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec 16, T.44 N., R. 7W., Mackinaw County, Michigan, and authorizes the President to sign same on behalf of the Conservancy. (See Appendix F.)
- 601-73 Fiborn Karst Preserve Geographic Features Names 7-22-89
The following names are adopted for the indicated geographic features of the Fiborn Karst Preserve:
Dry Creek.....gully leading north to Kochab Cave.
Cedar Creek...to west entrance to Hendrie River Water Cave.
Bridge Creek..main stream to HRWC.
Bog Creek.....to Reluctant Sinks.
Flat Creek....to sink near USGC bench mark.
Canyon Creek..from Fiborn Pond to quarry.
Little Creek..to Disgusting Cave.
Sinking Creek.to and from Quarry Cave.
Spring Creek..from system resurgence.
- 601-86 Fiborn Quarry Steam Engine Building 4-7-90
The FKPC will investigate the cost of repairing the steam engine shop building in Fiborn Quarry.

- 601-88 Request for Fiborn Karst Preserve Tax Exemption 4-7-90
The President is authorized to proceed with resolution of our request for property tax exemption.
- 601-108 Fiborn History Project Funding 4-4-92
The \$425 in FKP fund designated for Fiborn History Project use be budgeted for use by the History Project in preparing materials for the parking lot Kiosk.
- 601-112 Restoration and Preservation of Fiborn Machine Shop 11-21-92
The Fiborn Karst Preserve Committee is authorized to proceed with the development of a plan for sufficient restoration of the Fiborn Quarry Machine Shop building, to arrest its further deterioration and vandalism. The committee will report to the Board at its April 1993 meeting, with plans for restoration, cost estimates for the work, and plans for fund raising for the project.
- 601-130 Barb Patrie Memorial Fund and Trail 04-16-94
The MKC authorizes the Fiborn Karst Preserve Committee to use the Barb Patrie Memorial Fund in the following manner.
1. Designate the current Trail B as the Barb Patrie Memorial Trail and purchase an appropriate plaque for such a designation.
 2. Use the remainder of the fund for trail maintenance equipment and general trail maintenance as well as education and interpretive materials. Such education and interpretive material would note that their publication is made possible by the Barb Patrie Memorial Fund.
 3. The fund would remain available for donations and could provide ongoing funding for such items as trail guides and kiosk materials of an educational nature.
- 601-150 Designation of the Emma Kalnbach History Pavilion 9-20-97
In recognition of her dedicated teaching at the Fiborn Quarry school in the years 1933 to 1935, her contributions to and participation in the Fiborn Quarry History Project, and upon recommendation of the Preserve Committee of the Fiborn Karst Preserve, the Board of Trustees of the Michigan Karst Conservancy are pleased to name the history pavilion at the Preserve The Emma Kalnbach Pavilion
